We are looking forward to seeing parents and carers on Tuesday afternoon 17th May for parent/teacher interviews. If you are yet to return the note indicating your preferred times, please do so as soon as possible or contact your child's teacher via Seesaw. We are hoping to hold face-to-face meetings to reconnect with families in our school community. If you have scheduled an appointment but are unable to make it on the day, please notify your child's teacher via Seesaw. Kindergarten parent/teacher meetings were held in Term 1 and it is not necessary for the parents/carers of kindergarten children to schedule another meeting this term. Semester 1 written reports for all students will be sent home with your child on Thursday 30th June, 2022.

Well done to students in Year 3 and Year 5 who are completing NAPLAN. Their perseverance and efforts are acknowledged by our staff. Whilst the school reviews students' results to identify strengths and areas for development to assist with school planning, we recognise that this is one test on one day and the results are not always consistent with the learning we observe everyday in classrooms. If your child has been absent, they will have an additional opportunity to sit any assessments they missed over the next few days. NAPLAN reports will be distributed to parents and carers when they are received by the school.

Children 8 years and older are practising field events during weekly sport in preparation for our school Athletics Carnival later in the term. The track events and finals of the field events will be held on the day of the carnival. The school will send out a request for volunteers nearer to the date.

Please be advised that as part of the works being conducted on Graeme Street (Parking and Pedestrian upgrade Aberdeen Public School) new signage will be installed indicating where you can and can't park at pick up and drop off times. Until such time that this signage is installed, please be conscious of where you are parking and remember that road rules apply in this area. If parking is available in the Graeme Street carpark, please utilise these spaces and avoid double parking and blocking in parked cars. If exiting your vehicle, please ensure it is secured. Young children should not be left unattended if you are exiting the vehicle.

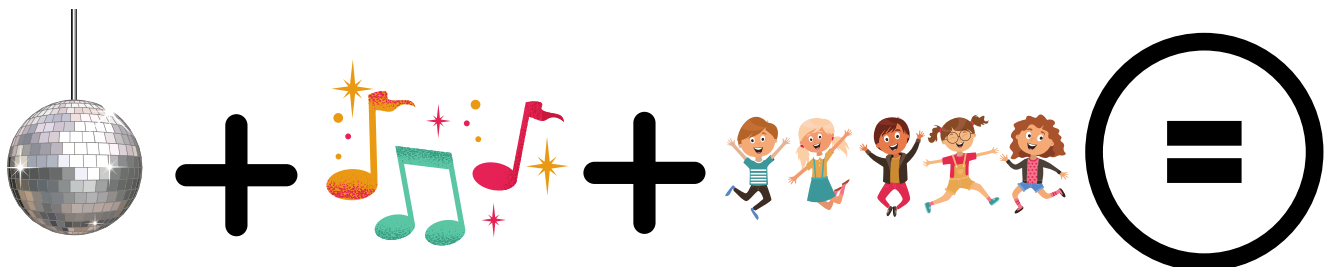
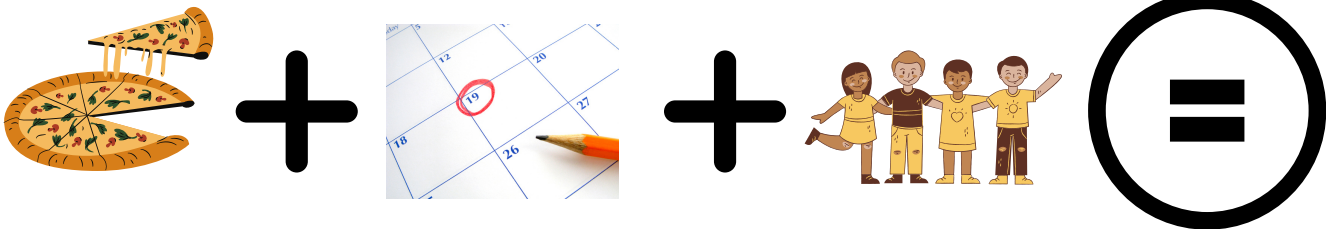

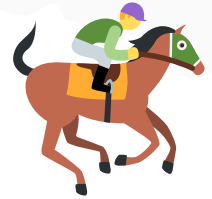
